Q: WHY JOIN A HOUSE CHURCH?

A: Joining a House Church provides a unique opportunity to experience deep, personal discipleship and meaningful community. In these smaller, diverse groups, you'll connect with others on a similar journey of faith, turning Sunday morning teachings into practical, lived experiences. House Churches foster genuine relationships through fellowship, prayer, and discussion, allowing for individual spiritual growth and support. This environment enables you to engage more deeply with Scripture, be encouraged in your walk with Christ, and contribute to a community where everyone is committed to growing together in faith.

Q: WHAT DOES A TYPICAL GATHERING LOOK LIKE?

A typical House Church gathering starts with a warm welcome and social time with snacks. This is followed by large group fellowship, prayer, or communion. A brief video teaching recaps Sunday's message, and then members break into small groups for deeper discussion and personal growth. This format helps connect Sunday teachings with daily Christian living and fosters community.

Q: WHERE DO THEY MEET?

Q: WHEN DO THEY MEET?

House Churches meet weekly on various days to fit different schedules: Sundays at either 3:00-4:30 PM or 6:30-8:00 PM, and Monday through Thursday from 7:00-8:30 PM.

Q: WHAT SORT OF PEOPLE COME TO A HOUSE CHURCH?

A• House Churches welcome a diverse mix of people from all walks of life. You'll find individuals of different ages, backgrounds, and levels of spiritual maturity coming together with a shared commitment to grow in their faith. The one thing that unites everyone is a desire to know Jesus better and to support each other on that journey.

Q: WHY DO HOUSE CHURCHES HAVE 30-40 PEOPLE? AREN'T CHURCH SMALL GROUPS USUALLY 6-12 PEOPLE?

House Churches at Renovation Church aim to strike a balance between the benefits of larger and smaller groups. With 30-40 people, they provide a lively, diverse community that supports meaningful connections and discussions, while still being small enough to be personal. This size helps blend the energy of a larger group with the close-knit feel of smaller gatherings, making for a rich and supportive experience.

Q: WHAT ABOUT CHILD CARE?

Families can drop off their kids, ages 0-10, at the church building for child care during House Church gatherings. For just \$5 per child, they'll enjoy games, snacks, and a Bible story. No pre-registration is needed, making it easy for parents to participate in House Church while their children are well cared for.

Q: HOW DO I CHOOSE WHICH HOUSE CHURCH TO JOIN?

Step 1: Choose a House Church that gathers near your home. This makes it easier to attend regularly and actively engage with the community.

Step 2: If the House Church closest to your home doesn't fit your schedule, select the next closest one that does.
